

## 2024 Colorado State 4-H Conference CSU Campus Fort Collins, CO

Youth/Adult Registration is a **flat fee of \$150**. Participants will need to select their desired lodging, contest (s), and workshops.

All contest individuals and teams must have a Coach and/or Adult chaperone that is an approved and enrolled Volunteer in 4-H Online for risk management and liability insurance. REQUIRED: ALL COACHES must register for the conference.

NOTE: Please review and work with your county extension office with ANY Questions.

2024 State Conference Workshops are set up by "Tracks": FCS, STEM and Leadership. For THURSDAY ONLY, there are two additional tracks for Livestock and Horse. These tracks will be traveling off campus to ARDEC (North of CSU) and Equine Center (West of CSU). The Equine Track will spend ALL DAY at the CSU Equine Center, including lunch. When signing up please select both the morning and afternoon options!

Review the workshop descriptions PRIOR to registration, which are located here.

NOTE: Workshops require foot travel across campus, please wear appropriate footwear. Workshops are on a 1st come/1st served basis. If you sign up for a "Track" the group will stay together and move from workshop to workshop together for either the entire morning and/or afternoon. It is best to select a different "track" when there are AM or PM options for FCS, STEM and LEADERSHIP. Equine and Livestock are designed for the groups to be together the entire day.

For each track, **select 1 Option**. The 2 tracks will run simultaneously with a cap of 25 per track. For Example: Tuesday, June 18 PM
Workshop, the 4-H member will select 1 option. Even if that option is "Participating in a Contest."
