- The goal of this team was to create an online version of the required MQA training for you to take from your homes at your own convenience.   TEST. You must take this test and pass it with 80% in order to consider your training complete. You must also
  fully complete the training modules.

## STEPS to take this version of the Colorado 4-H MQA Training:

- 2. You will need to create an account.
  - a. Emails can only be used once to enroll in the course. So each participant will need their own email address.
  - b. Once registered with CANVAS a link will be emailed to you to finish setting up your account so that you can return to the class.
