This contest is open to members who are enrolled in the 4-H Dog project.

All 4-H Dog Health Certificates are to be on 4HOnline. The county will complete the online portion of the registration process on behalf of its participants.

Each entrant is required to complete the State Dog Identification in 4HOnline by May 1st. This form will be used at the State Fair Dog Show .

If there is not a rabies immunization, the participant must get a certificate from the veterinarian stating the reason and must accompany the member to the contest.

State Fair 4-H Dog Show Officials and/or staff can and will dismiss any entrant or his/her family for any mistreatment of dogs entered in the show.
