PLEASE MAKE ALL CHECKS PAYABLE TO: CSU/4-H CAMP TOBIN

- LODGING:** The price for lodging is **\$10 per night**. Reservations and payment are due at the State 4-H Office postmarked by July 30. Lodging with meals is available on these dates: August 14 through the night of August 19; August 23 through the night of August 26; and August 31 through the night of Sept. 3, on a space- available basis for 4-H members, leaders, parents, superintendents and judges participating in 4-H activities at the State Fair. Lodging only (without meals) is available on the following dates: August 22; August 27 –Aug. 30; and Sept. 3. For more information about Camp Tobin reservations, please contact the State 4-H Office (970-491-7883) or, after August 13th, the Camp Tobin Office (719-561-3480).
- RATE:** **\$10.00**/per person per night. Health forms required for all youth (19 and under).
- DORMS:** Equipped with mattresses on bunked beds and locker for belongings (must bring own lock).
- BRING:** Bedding/sleeping bag, pillow, towels and personal items
- RESERVATIONS:** First-come, first-serve basis. Dormitory doors are closed and locked at 11:00 p.m. There will be no admittance after 11:00 p.m. unless prior arrangements were made with the dormitory superintendent.
- PAYMENT:** Refunds will be given only for lodging cancellations that are **seven (7) days** prior to your reservation date. Reservations and payment are due at the State 4-H office, postmarked by July 30. For late reservation information, please contact your county Extension office. **Refunds will not be given for meals because the food has been pre-purchased.**
- RULES:** **ALL** youth and adults residing in the dorms during state fair must read, sign and follow the dormitory rules. The use of drugs (except prescribed medicines), beer or other alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited for anyone on the 4-H grounds or in the 4-H dormitories. No smoking is permitted in the dormitory. Failure to comply with these rules will result in an individual being banned from staying in the 4-H dorms. No animals may be kept in the dormitory, in compliance with public health codes.
- SUPERVISION:** **ALL youth must have an adult from their county with them and supervising them. They must be accountable to that adult.** No youth reservations will be accepted without adult supervision being provided by the county, club or a parent. There will be no dorm superintendents again this year.
- MEALS:** Breakfast, lunch and dinner served Aug. 15 through Aug. 18; breakfast served on Aug. 19. Dinner served on Aug. 23; breakfast, lunch and dinner served on Aug. 24 and 25; and breakfast and lunch served on Aug. 26. Dinner served on August 31; breakfast, lunch and dinner served on Sept. 1; and breakfast and lunch served on Sept. 2 (**contingent on reservations**).
- If no advance food reservations are made, walk-ins will be served on a "food available" basis 10 minutes prior to the end of each scheduled meal.**

- Registration for Camp Tobin will be done through 4HOnline. Once you have registered everyone, print out the invoice connected to each family member and send it with payment (one check for the total amount) to one of the addresses listed above, depending on the date. For questions about registration, please contact the State 4-H Office at 970-491-7883 or, on or after August 13, contact the Camp Tobin Office at 719- 561-3480. **All registrations must be done on 4HOnline.** (No faxed or mailed registrations will be accepted.)
 - Meals and lodging are confirmed by **advance reservation and payment.**
 - Confirm and claim all lodging reservations and meal tickets at 4-H Camp Tobin office immediately upon arrival at the Colorado State Fairgrounds in Pueblo, CO.

DORMITORY

- DORMS OPEN:
- Aug. 14 through the night of Aug. 19; Aug 23 through the night of Aug. 26; and July 31 through the night of Sept. 3. Check-out must be completed by noon on Tuesday, September 4.
 - **RATE: \$10.00 per bed per night.**
 - Payment in full must accompany all confirmed reservations.
 - **CHECK-IN TIME:** Office hours are 8:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. If you will be late, you must make arrangements in advance by calling the 4-H Camp Tobin Office at 719-561-3480 before 5:30 p.m. on the day of arrival.
 - All reservations are on a first come, first serve basis.
 - Lodging reserved on a space available basis.
 - Children over age five must stay in their respective gender dorm, have their own bed or cot and have a same-sex adult chaperone. **No children are to be left unattended in the dorms at any time.** Children under age five may stay in the dorm free if the chaperoning parent brings a cot or portable crib and places child's bed next to the chaperones bed. (Please be considerate of others if you have a crying child.)
 - Chaperones are required for all youth.

WHEN THE WOMENS DORMITORY IS FULL, NO SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS WILL BE MADE IN THE MENS DORMITORY!

- 4-H DINING
- **One day advance meal purchase required** in order to provide enough food. If you buy a meal ticket on the same day you need it, you will be served on a food availability basis.
 - **All reservations for meals are considered firm with advance payment. No refunds will be given for missed meals.**
 - Meal service begins with breakfast at 7:00 a.m., on Wednesday, August 15.
 - Dorms will be available on August 22 – no meals. Dorms also available August 27 – through July 30 – no meals.
- REFUND POLICY:
- Dormitory reservations canceled at least **seven (7) days** prior to first night reservation date will be refunded.
 - Meal reservations canceled at least **seven (7) days prior** to first meal reservation date will be refunded.

ALL refunds, financial disputes, etc. , require the claim be made in the 4-H Camp Tobin office prior to the close of state fair. Once the 4-H Camp Tobin office is closed, any and all claims will be forfeited. All refunds will be mailed to recipients during the month of September following the close of the state fair.

NO DORMITORY OR MEAL REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN WITH LESS THAN SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR NOTICE UNLESS A BONAFIDE EMERGENCY HAS OCCURRED.

- HELPFUL HINTS:
- It saves a lot of time if chaperones/leaders have all health forms and dormitory rules and responsibilities (both youth and adult forms) completed and signed **PRIOR TO** arrival.
