

Judging Leadership

The Leadership project is divided into four units. Unit 1 is only for juniors (ages 8-10). Units 2-4 are for intermediates (ages 11-13) and seniors (ages 14 and older).

INDIVIDUAL SKILLS FOR OLDER MEMBERS---Intermediates and Seniors

SKILLS WORKING WITHIN GROUPS—Intermediates and Seniors

SKILLS LEADING GROUPS---Intermediates and Seniors

Exhibit should consist of:

General for all photography units:

1. Project manual and/or attached materials presented in a sturdy binder.
2. Attachments materials should include: Planning Your Project –Step 1-4; Personal Skill Assessment Guide (units 2 and 3 only); Two activities and analysis completed in each skill area.
3. e-record
4. A showboard illustrating leadership skills learned from the project year. The display may also include photographs of how the member practiced leadership skills with others.

Extra things to look for:

1. Pictures of activities they have participated in
2. Sharing information they learned through talks, demonstrations, and displays.
3. Neatness and legibility in the manual and showboard
4. Quality of completion in the manual
