4-H Showmanship, Rally Obedience and Obedience Classes

Showmanship

Junior Novice Showmanship - First year in dog project and age 8-10
Junior Open Showmanship - Second year or above in dog project and age 8-10
Intermediate Novice Showmanship - First year in dog project and age 11-13
Intermediate Open Showmanship - Second year or above in dog project and age 11-13
Intermediate Advanced Showmanship - Members ages 11-13 and have placed 1st through 10th at a previous State Dog Trial in Intermediate Open Showmanship
Senior Novice Showmanship - First year in dog project and age 14+
Senior Open Showmanship - Second year or higher in dog project and age 14+
Senior Advanced Showmanship - Members ages 14-18 and have placed 1st through 10th at a previous State Dog Trial in Senior Open Showmanship
Master Showmanship - Members ages 11-18 and have placed Grand or Reserve Grand Champion at the Colorado State Fair.

Rally Obedience

Rally Novice A: This class is for members and their dogs in their first year of Rally Novice Obedience.
Rally Novice B: This class is for any member who is in their second year or above of Rally Novice who have never received a qualifying ribbon at a previous County Fair in this class or who is starting a new dog which has never competed in Rally Novice.
Rally Intermediate A: This class is for members and their dogs in their first year of Rally Intermediate training.
Rally Advanced A: This class is for members in their first year of Rally Advanced training.
Rally Advanced B: This class is for any member who is in their second year or above of Rally Advanced who have never received a qualifying blue ribbon at a previous County Fair in this class or who is starting a new dog which has never competed in Rally Advanced.
Rally Excellent A: This class is for members who are in their first year of Rally Excellent training.
Rally Excellent B: This class is for any member who is in their second year or above of Rally Excellent who has never received a qualifying blue ribbon at a previous County Fair in this class or who is starting a new dog which has never competed in Rally Excellent.
Rally Advanced/Excellent A: This class is for members who are in their first year of Rally Advanced/Excellent training.
Rally Advanced/Excellent B: This class is for any member who is in their second year or above of Rally Advanced/Excellent or who is starting a new dog which has never competed in Rally Advanced/Excellent.

4-H Showmanship, Rally Obedience and Obedience Classes

Obedience

Beginner Novice A: This class is open to handlers and their dogs who have not qualified in Sub-Novice Obedience or above.

Beginner Novice B: This class is open to handlers and dogs that have qualified in Sub-Novice or above at a County level, but are not ready for the next level. Dogs with National titles in this class are not eligible.

Beginner Novice C (1st year): This class is open to experienced handlers with a first year dog only. You may show in this class one year only unless you start with another first year dog.

Beginner Novice C (2nd year): This class is open only to those members in their second year of Beginner Novice C training with the same dog that showed the previous year in Beginner Novice C who have never received a blue ribbon at a previous County Fair in this class.

Novice A: This class is open to members with no prior experience in Novice dog training.

Novice B: This class is open to experienced handlers in their second year of Novice 4-H Dog Training or above with a new dog or who have never received a blue ribbon at a previous County Fair in this class.

Veterans Class: For dogs that have obtained a qualifying score in a Novice class and are at least 7 years of age on the date of the show. Veteran dogs will compete at the obedience level the member chooses, from Novice up through Utility. A dog may not be entered in any other obedience class if they enter the Veteran's Class.

Pre Grad Novice A: This class is open to members with no prior experience in Pre Graduate Novice Dog Training.

Pre Grad Novice B: This class is open to experienced handlers in their second year of Novice 4-H Dog Training or above with a new dog or who have never received a blue ribbon at a previous County Fair in this class.

Grad Novice A: This class is open to members with no prior experience in Graduate Novice Dog Training

Grad Novice B: This class is open to experienced handlers in their second year or above with a new dog or who have never received a blue ribbon at a previous County Fair in this class.

Open A: Open to members with no prior experience in this class.

Open B: Open to experienced Open handlers in their second year or above in this class.

Utility A: Open to members with no prior experience in this class.

Utility B: Open to experienced Utility handlers in their second year or above in this class.

Puppy Class: This class is for puppies that are not ready for regular obedience classes. The purpose of this class will be to introduce obedience commands to a puppy without the stress of perfection seen in regular obedience classes. This class will introduce the puppy to dog shows in a positive manner, thus setting the puppy up for a life time of enjoyment in the show ring. Older/Senior dogs may enter this class if they are not able to perform the exercises in other classes, but must have approval from the Key Leader.
