Rules

1. All 4-H rules apply as far as conduct and show ring attire. A Code of Conduct policy will be provided and must be read before enrolling. Show ring attire must consist of; Shirt with collar and sleeves (short or long sleeve), pants with a belt, no cap or hat, no tank tops, hair combed, etc.
2. Any child under the age of 8 as of January 1st 2019 is not permitted to show cattle for the showmanship buckle.
3. All Park County Fairgrounds rules apply.
4. A registration fee of \$25 will be required at the time of registration for all exhibitors from visiting counties. Park County participants are required to pay a fee of \$15 dollars per Kid at the time of registration. All entry fees are non-refundable. **Early Registration due date is May 8th, 2019. After May 8th, 2019 the Registration fee will increase to \$40.**
5. All Park County Fair clipping and fitting rules are not in forced for this event.
6. Upon arrival all participants are to go to the registration table and register on what species you will be showing. All participants bringing livestock to show must be on grounds and in place by 8:30 AM on June 1st.
7. Each participant is allowed to bring and show more than one species if so desired. Pen fees for extra animals may be charged.
8. Participants that bring their own animals are the only participants allowed to show and the only participants eligible for showmanship awards. This includes any participants from another county. All participants are eligible for door prizes.
9. All participants are responsible for the fairgrounds and to make sure it is left in a clean condition before dismissal.
10. Participants are required to furnish straw or shavings for their stalls. Which type will be up to the opinion of the participant? (Shavings are easier to clean)
11. All swine entries must water their animals from automatic waters.
12. **Animals that attend the event must be of good health and will have a health check on-site at no charge before they are let out of their trailers onto the fair ground.**
13. The Judge's decisions on June 1st are final.
14. The Park County Livestock Committee reserves the right to add, change, or enforce these rules at any time in which they see fit
