F.	Demonstrate the ability to track and rate a cow 100 feet in two directions without building a loop. Demonstrating being in position to rope.		
G.	Rider must rope a cow using a head or horn loop, safely dally and stop their horse, keeping the horse facing the cow to release the breakaway hondo. If member fails to catch additional attempts will be at the discretion of the evaluator/rater. (quality of cattle should be considered)
