Both jars must be filled to the same level. Jars must be labeled on the bottom of the jar with name, county, class, where honey was extracted and date.

Not complete means that there is something missing and needs a comment as to what is missing or why it is not complete. Project will be evaluated on the quality of information completed in e-record (25 percent) and quality of exhibit (75 percent).
