Exhibit: Completed Leathercraft e-Record and two completed, stamped leather articles.

Unit 1—Intro to Leathercraft & Creative Stamping: Exhibit items are on a board 12" x 18" x 1/8" or 1/4" (preferably pegboard) to which items are attached by means of lacing or thread.

- 1. One completed article or one matched set of articles with a creative stamping design on a single layer of leather. Only a clear finish may be used. Examples: belt, bookmark, wrist bracelet, set of coasters.
- One completed article with a creative stamping design on at least two pieces of leather that are hand sewed together with lacing and/or thread stitching using whip stitch, running stitch, or saddle stitch. Only a clear finish may be used. Examples: coin purse, knife sheath/case, simple purse, wallet. Pre-cut or self-cut kits are allowed. Not Permitted: Carving, color shading or dyeing, antiquing, or machine sewing.

 Judges may use the back of the form for more comments.

Judging Element 1: 4-He-Record: Complete means everything has been filled out. Not complete means there is something missing and needs a comment as to what is missing or why it is not complete. Project will be evaluated on the quality of information completed in e-record (25 %) and quality of exhibit (75 %).
