Unit 4—Advanced Leather Carving: One completed article, matching set, or picture/wall hanging using one of the following techniques: advanced traditional carving, figure carving, pictorial carving, decorative swivel knife carving, embossing or filigree work. (Note: All pictures meant to be hung need to be complete with hardware to hang for display, whether framed or not.) Clear finish, staining/antiquing, two tone finishes, and background dyeing are allowed in Unit 4. Any lacing, hand sewing, and/or machine sewing may be used in Unit 4, though they are not required. **Not Permitted:** Solid color dyeing or color shading (only background dyeing is permitted).
Judges may use the back of the form for more comments.

Judging Element 1: 4-H e-Record: Complete means everything has been filled out. Not complete means there is something missing and needs a comment as to what is missing or why it is not complete. Project will be evaluated on the quality of information completed in e-record (25 %) and quality of exhibit (75 %).
