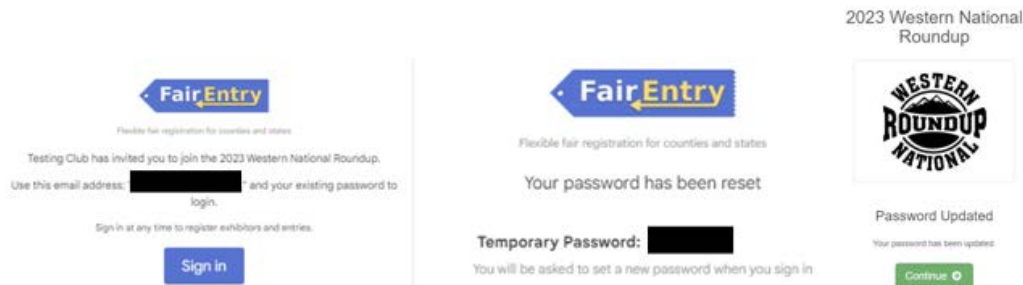




Western National Roundup

Registration Instructions

1. From the Western National Roundup website, download the [Authorized State Official Form](#) and [Consent Forms](#). These forms will be a REQUIRED upload during the registration process.
2. To register a state team (s). One person from each institution, school or FFA chapter **MUST complete this online form**. **NOTE: If you participated last year, go to the FairEntry link (below) and reset password. Proceed to Step 3.** Once this information is received the person (s) responsible for registration will receive a welcome email from FairEntry (welcome link and reset and update password) and **Continue** to "[2024 Western National Roundup](#)" Registration. **NOTE: \$250 per contest per participant. No registration fee for coaches. Award reception fee of \$50 per person using the Coach/Chaperone/Coordinator section.**



3. Once successfully logged in, select

FairEntry Exhibitor, Staff Sign-In
