



## Colorado 4-H Shooting Sports State Championships

### Archery

#### Range Volunteers

FITA – needs 7 volunteers per 2-hour time slot; 3D – needs 6 safety officers. Volunteers would be asked to work a 2-hour slot to fill the positions throughout the entire day. \*All individuals working on the range must have a current certification in Archery.

#### Safety Officer

- Safety Officers will spread throughout the range and keep an eye on 8-10 kids each.
- Watch for any safety concerns/issues and address them appropriately either by talking to the participant or calling a cease fire if needed.
  - This includes ensuring that the youth are straddling the firing line, helping assist with dropped arrows, etc.
- Assist youth with scoring
  - Youth score each other, but if they have questions, safety officers assist youth to answer questions
  - On relays where there are too many youths from one county, volunteers would help the youth score, so they aren't scoring someone from their own county.
- Assist the Range Officers with any other needs.

\*All volunteers must have closed-toed shoes.

\*Volunteers who are assisting with **scoring only** do not have to be certified but must wear closed-toed shoes.

\*You may volunteer on ranges that have youth from your county on it, just no coaching them.

\*If you can volunteer, please see Michelle Butterworth at the check-in table to let her know that you are willing and able, or if you hear a call for volunteers, please check in at the registration area.

It takes a minimum of 13 volunteers on the line at a time, so please volunteer your time!
