**Exhibit:** Completed Beekeeping Unit 2-4 e-Record. Exhibit: A detailed notebook describing your project including your goals, plans, accomplishments, and your evaluation of results. You may use pictures or any records you have kept that provide evidence of your accomplishments. This notebook is your main project exhibit and will count for 75 percent of the scoring. If an item was made as part of the project, a sample may be displayed as further evidence of the quality of the project. Display must not require over a 2' x 2' x 2' area or consist of more than three items. A label must be on the back of the notebook and optional display item, and if an additional item is displayed, another label should be on the back or bottom of the item.

**Judging Element 1:** 4-H e-Record: Complete means that everything has been filled out. Not complete means that there is something missing and needs a comment as to what is missing or why it is not complete. Project will be evaluated on the quality of information completed in e-record (25 percent) and quality of exhibit (75 percent).
