Exhibit: Completed Home Design and Decor e-Record secured in a sturdy binder. Include in e-record: goals, your plan, accomplishments, resources, how you shared your project and how you evaluated your project. Select from the following for an exhibit:

1. Design board (art board, corrugated plastic, etc.) 22 x 30 inches. The design board will include samples of paint, fabric, flooring, etc., for the room you are designing. **OR**

2. Job Shadow – display board (3'x4') demonstrating: what profession you are interested in, who you job shadowed (professional, job title of person shadowing), what you learned from the experience, and if you still want to be in the profession, why or why not? You may use pictures or any record you have kept providing evidence of your job shadow experience and what you learned. **OR**

3. Portfolio Exhibit –

- A physical representation of the career or business product such as a model, prototype or display/portfolio that includes images of accomplished work.
- Written explanation that demonstrates knowledge of the related career or business fields, potential careers, and the appropriate requirement for achievement in those fields. Judges may use the back of the form for more comments.

Judging Element 1: 4-H e-Record: Complete means that everything has been filled out. Not complete means that there is something missing and needs a comment as to what is missing or why it is not complete. Project will be evaluated on the quality of information completed in e-record (25 percent) and quality of exhibit (75 percent).
