<b>Labels:</b> All photos must have the following: Camera Used Activity # Photo # (left to right, and top to bottom) Subject Date Photo Taken					
<b>Activity 1 – 2 photos</b> a. – 2 photos using different lenses for each photo					
<b>Activity 2 – 2 photos</b> a. – 2 photos using (2) special effects from the suggestions on page 16, or special effects lenses					
<b>Activity 3 – 4 photos</b> a. – 2 photos using hard light b. – 2 photos using soft light					

<b>Activity 4 – 2 photos</b> a. – choose your 2 best reflection photos that have good composition					
<b>Activity 5 – 2 Photos</b> a. – 1 photo using artificial light b. – 1 photo using natural light					
<b>Activity 6 – 2 photos</b> a. – 1 photo demonstrating the rule of thirds in landscape view b. – 1 photo demonstrating the rule of thirds in portrait view					
<b>Activity 7 – 2 photos</b> a. – 1 photo demonstrating the golden triangle using transparent template b. – 1 photo demonstrating the golden rectangle using transparent template					
<b>Activity 8 – 3 photos</b> a. – 3 photos that are of different subjects from different angles or viewpoints					
<b>Activity 9 – 2 photos</b> a. – 2 photos using composition elements and space in the photo to tell the story					
<b>Activity 10 – 2 photos</b> a. – 2 candid photos					
<b>Activity 11 – 1 photo</b> a. – 1 photo that fills the entire frame of the photo with a piece of the subject					
<b>Activity 12 – 1 photo</b> a. – 1 panorama photo					
<b>Activity 13 – 2 photos</b> a. – 1 photo that shows warm colors b. – 1 photo that shows cool colors					
<b>Activity 14 – 4 photos</b> a. – 4 photos, each photo should have a specific purpose behind it. Be sure to use the skills and techniques learned so far during the units to take quality photos for this activity.
