**Exhibit:** Completed Heritage Arts e-Record presented in a sturdy binder. One finished item illustrating what was learned. Items should include one of the following: 1. Simple pieced quilt (lap size or smaller); 2. Pillow; 3. Pillow Sham; 4. Two placemats. Items must be quilted – machined or tied. No separate binding should be used. Items should be finished using a roll-over/self-binding or an envelope turn. Consistent use of  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams required. Two or more of the following required techniques allowed: sandwiching, cutting of precuts and/or stitched pieces, straight block pattern, nesting seams, use of sashing, modification of original pattern. No advanced quilting techniques from Units 3-5 used. Fabric selection allowed: yardage, pre-printed panel, pre-cuts. Judges may use the back of the form for more comments.

**Judging Element 1:** 4-H e-Record: Complete means that everything has been filled out. Not complete means that there is something missing and needs a comment as to what is missing or why it is not complete. Project will be evaluated on the quality of information completed in e-record (25 percent) and quality of exhibit (75 percent).
