Two or more of the following required techniques: Triangle patterns, embellishments (includes non-stitched appliques), fussy cuts, mitered corners, on-point rows, challenging fabric, flange, or other embellished borders. Exhibit should not use any techniques from Unit 4. Fabric selection allowed: yardage, applique pre-cuts. Judges may use the back of the form for more comments.

Judging Element 1: 4-H e-Record: Complete means that everything has been filled out. Not complete means that there is something missing and needs a comment as to what is missing or why it is not complete. Project will be evaluated on the quality of information completed in e-record (25 percent) and quality of exhibit (75 percent).
