1 POINT PENALTIES

- A. Loss of working advantage
- B. Working out of position

3 POINT PENALTIES

- A. Cattle picked up or scattered
- B. Spurring in front of the cinch
- C. Horse pawing or biting cattle
- D. Back fence

5 POINT PENALTIES

- A. Quitting the cow
- B. Losing the cow
- C. Not driving cow between marker and corner of pen, prior to penning
- D. Blatant disobedience

10 POINT PENALTY

- A. No penning by time limit (2 1/2 min)
- B. Anytime more than one head enters the pen

ZERO SCORE – not eligible to place

- A. Illegal equipment
- B. Turn tail
- C. Running into the herd- Excessive disturbance of the herd or running into the herd (to the point where the exhibitor is asked to leave the arena).
- D. Illegal use of hands (See 300D. page 94)
- E. Herd holders aiding the contestant inappropriately (See rule book)
- F. Fall of horse or rider.
- G. Abuse of the cow, including running the cow into the fence, or if the judge feels that the cow is being abused in any way
- H. Visible blood inside the mouth, on shoulder or sides
- I. Never successfully sorting a cow

When working a cow, rider will not be penalized for holding the cantle or horn of the saddle.

NEW COW

Only when cattle are numbered, the judge may award a rider a new cow based on the following:

- A. Cow will not or cannot run
- B. Cow will not leave the herd or the end of the arena
- C. Cow is blind or will not yield to the horse
- D. Cow leaves the arena

Judge may blow his/her whistle at any time to terminate the work. A score of zero will be given, if the work is not complete at that time. 2 and half minute time limit for each horse. Scoring is on the basis of 1-100, with 70 denoting an average performance.
