1 POINT PENALTIES

- A. Loss of working advantage
- B. Slipping a rein
- C. Excessive whipping, spurring, or hollering
- D. Failure to drive cow down the fence to designated marker
- E. For each length horse runs past cow
- F. Using corner or end of arena to turn cow
- G. Changing sides of arena to turn cow
- H. Working out of position

2 POINT PENALTIES

- A. Going around corner of arena before stopping or turning cow
- B. Driving cow down the middle of arena and stopping in the middle of the arena. (Driving cow at least 20 ft. off the side of the arena wall would be considered middle of the arena)
- C. No catch after two loops (see rule 342.B)

3 POINT PENALTIES

- A. Exhausting or overworking before driving cow down fence
- B. Knocking down cow without having working advantage
- C. Failure or refusal to turn

5 POINT PENALTIES

- A. Not getting a turn each way (5 points each way)
- B. Spurring or hitting in front of the cinch at anytime
- C. Blatant disobedience including kicking, biting, bucking, rearing and striking or obviously insubordinate
- D. Loss of cow

10 POINT PENALTIES

- A. Dropping the rope

Judge may blow the whistle at any time to terminate the cow work. Rider will box for 50 sec. Once 50 sec. warning is given, rider will take cow down one side of arena past the halfway mark and stop. Rider must not attempt to stop or turn cow once it has gone down the fence. Riders are allowed a minute and a half to complete the class/run.

Zero Score- not eligible to place or receive a ribbon

- A. Illegal equipment or illegal use of equipment
- B. Illegal use of hands (See Rule 300D, page 94)
- C. Failure to attempt part of the class
- D. Excessive running or abuse of cattle, including but not limited to running cow into fence
- E. Turn tail (to turn away from cow turning tail to the cow)
- F. Out of control
- G. Fall of horse or rider
- H. Schooling between cows, if new cow is awarded
- I. Failure to quit working a cow after a new cow has been awarded
- J. Willful abuse including but not limited to: whipping or striking the horse with hand or equipment
- K. Visible blood inside the mouth, shoulders, or sides

GUIDE FOR "NEW COW" (At judge's discretion, rider may receive a new cow(s) as necessary to show horse)

- Cow that will not or cannot run
- Cow is blind in one or both eyes
- Cow that doesn't yield to the horse
- When cow leaves arena

When working a cow, a rider shall not be penalized for holding onto the cantle or horn of the saddle.
