Designated Two-page layout in 8 1/2" x 11" or 12" x 12". Formatted to go together in a set (a two-page spread) that is coordinated by color and design which follows a theme with good logical order. Place the two-page layout in an appropriately sized binder in protective archival safe sleeves. Pages shall contain techniques from your technique list that you have chosen to use in your project. Create pages that are pleasing to the eye, items are not cluttered, and colors are appropriate to subject matter. Must be exhibited in a three-ring binder or scrapbook binder. Only submit the two pages to be judged. Journaling and titling must be included on the two-page layout. Judges may use the back of the form for more comments.

Judging Element 1: 4-H e-Record: Complete means that everything has been filled out. Not complete means that there is something missing and needs a comment as to what is missing or why it is not complete. Project will be evaluated on the quality of information completed in e-record (25 percent) and quality of exhibit (75 percent).
