Exhibit: Completed Heritage Arts e-Record presented in a sturdy binder. One piece or a set of up to three coordinated pieces illustrating what was learned. Can be ethnic. Fiber-with a minimum of 50 percent yarn/fabric (Example: weavings, spun skeins, felted bags, batiked fabric, hooked pillows, Navajo rug, etc.). Non-Fiber-with no yarn or fabric (Examples: Native American beading, silver smithing, Ukrainian eggs, paper scrolling, wood carving, etc.). Judges may use the back of the form for more comments. Small (less than 6"x6") or delicate items should be mounted on an 8"x10" foam core board.

Judging Element 1: 4-H e-Record: Complete means that everything has been filled out. Not complete means that there is something missing and needs a comment as to what is missing or why it is not complete. Project will be evaluated on the quality of information completed in e-record (25 percent) and quality of exhibit (75 percent).
