How it works:

Colorado 4-H is pleased to partner with The Department of Design and Merchandising at Colorado State University to showcase outstanding youth creativity in the Gustafson Gallery this fall. During judging at the Colorado State Fair, up to 30 projects from Artistic Clothing, Clothing Construction, Heritage Arts, Home Design and Décor, and Leathercraft will be selected for exhibition, highlighting work that reflects the gallery's focus on design, creativity, and craftsmanship.

- 1 Projects are selected at State Fair.
- 2 Youth decide if they would like their project displayed and complete a release form.
- 3 CSU will coordinate project travel from Pueblo to Fort Collins. Projects are displayed in the Gustafson Gallery.
- 4 Projects return home after the exhibit ends in December.

Youth do not need to be Grand Champions, or even Champions, to be selected for this opportunity. Youth who are selected will be notified after judging to see if they want their exhibit displayed and then there is a release form for them to complete.

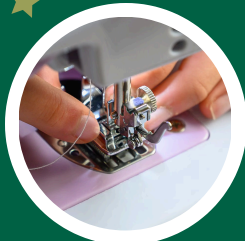
